Barkow's all-welded aluminum or stainless steel glazing trailer is designed to carry glass and frames to the jobsite. It has a gross vehicle weight rating of 9,900.

The exterior glass racks are 144 by 96 inches with ten Stake-Loc stakes and eight-inch useable ledgeboards on each side. The 144-inch interior deck holds frames.



Other features include: "B" loadholding slats throughout, electric brakes on both axles, vertical interior walls and removable wheel covers. The trailer is custom manufactured and available in 10-foot to 16-foot lengths.

doors Get Rated

The hurricane-resistant K2 Summit Door by Aldora Aluminum and Glass Products is now ADA compliant and has a water rating. The product has been impact tested to Miami-Dade protocol and is awaiting an NOA and Florida Building Code approval, according to the company.

It comes in maximum sizes of 4-by-10-foot singles or 8-by-10-foot pairs.

In its ADA-compliant, water-rated configuration, the K2 Summit can achieve ratings of 60 pounds per square foot and nine pounds of water without unsightly ramps required. A step-up threshold is also available, as well as multiple panic options including Regent, Adams Rite, Sargent and Von Duprin. Other options offered are a 3/4-inch sub frame, 9/16-inch or 1 5/16-inch glazing, a continuous gear hinge and a ten-inch bottom rail.
